InVivo Therapeutics CEO Frank Reynolds to Introduce Massachusetts Governor Deval Patrick at Bio2009

Cambridge, MA--- InVivo Therapeutics President and CEO Frank Reynolds will introduce Massachusetts Governor Deval Patrick for his keynote speech at Bio2009. Bio2009 is a four-day annual convention for biotechnology being held in Atlanta from May 18-21, 2009.

Reynolds will introduce Governor Patrick on Tuesday afternoon in a ceremony at the Georgia World Congress Center where the convention is taking place.

"With companies like Genzyme, Amgen, Biogen and Boston Scientific located in Massachusetts, we consider this an incredible honor and also a testament to the quality of work that InVivo's team has been doing," Reynolds says.
